

ORDINANCE NO. 220-08

AN ORDINANCE OF UINTAH CITY REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE No. 70-82 WITH A NEW ORDINANCE ENTITLED PARKING, PARKING DURING SNOWSTORMS, AND IMPOUNDMENT OF VEHICLES IN VIOLATIONS

In the opinion of the Uintah City Council, this Ordinance is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Uintah City, Weber County, State of Utah.

WHEREAS, the current ordinance is in need of updating the procedures, and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Uintah City Council that the Parking, Parking During Snowstorms, And Impoundment Of Vehicles Ordinance shall be as follows:

- Section 1 Title
- Section 2. Purpose & Goals
- Section 3. Effective Date

Section 1. Title

The name of this ordinance shall be known as Parking, Parking During Snowstorms, and Impoundment of Vehicles.

Section 2. Purpose and Goals

The purpose shall be to provide, to adequately remove snow, and to avoid property damage as far as possible.

The goal shall be to promote and if necessary to keep public streets and highways clear of all parked vehicles and other obstacles left on or adjacent to the travel way during the winter months and snow events.

Parking During Winter Months:

1. No person, who owns or has possession, control, or custody of any vehicle, shall park, or allow or permit another to park any such vehicle upon any public street or in city rights-of-way between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., between the months and days of the 1st of December to the 1st of March.
2. During all times, other than those set forth in paragraph 1 above, no person, who owns or has possession, custody, or control of any vehicle, shall park, or allow or permit another to park any such vehicle upon any public street when the removal of snow from the streets is necessary, apparent or imminent, and 72 hours after the snowstorm event.
3. A violation of this Section is a Class C Misdemeanor. Any person convicted hereunder for the first time shall be assessed a fine not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00), with any other sentence the court deems appropriate. The sentencing for any subsequent offense shall be within the discretion of the court.

Impoundment of Vehicles in Violation:

Any vehicle in violation of the parking laws set out in this ordinance may be impounded by the Authorized policing Agency or Department to a place of storage selected by the Agency or Department.

Section 3. Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon posting and passage. Passed, approved, and adopted this 19th day of February 2008.
